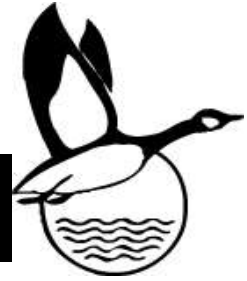

HUTTERITE DOWN DUVETS

Hutterite down is produced in the Hutterite communities located in Alberta, Canada. Temperatures range from -50c during the winter, to 35c during summer months. The Hutterite groups emigrated from Europe many years ago. They live peacefully in self sustaining communities while following their traditional religious practices. They live a simple agricultural lifestyle by using the farming skills of generations past which also include the raising of free range geese. Agricultural and farming skills are passed down from generation to generation and are considered traditional and less affected by modern technology. Geese are allowed free range over the land in keeping with the Hutterite tradition.

Geese live in their natural living conditions and down is always removed gently and manually from the mature birds. Then the Hutterite down will be cleaned twice using soap rather than a chemical cleaning process. Once thoroughly and safely cleaned, it is sorted by hand and ensures that Hutterite down contains 90% to 95% down and only 5% - 10% small feathers. This ratio is higher than industry standards of 75% and why Hutterite down is so highly treasured.

With an 800 fill power, it is the best graded down of all domestic downs raised in North America. You can be assured a Maholi Hutterite Down Duvet will bring you years of warmth and comfort along with a great night's sleep.
