Harvested Only By Cree Indians

Next to Eiderdown, Northern Canadian Link Goose Down (also known as Arctic Goose Down) is simply the best goose down in the world. This down is collected from wild Canadian Grey Geese in northern Canada along the shores of Hudson Bay and James Bay. Only the Cree Indians, under special permission from the Canadian Government, are allowed to collect this precious commodity. It can only be collected twice a year, once in the spring and once in the fall. Consequently, Northern Canadian Link Goose Down is available in very limited supply.

Since Canadian Grey Geese must be able to fly up to 15,000 km during their two migrations every year, these wild birds are hardy, large and very strong. They can live for up to 25 years.

Their down clusters are very mature and large. The loft is over 700 fill power and it has a superior clinging ability similar to the much more expensive Eiderdown. The high density down clusters link together giving it its high insulating power also similar to Eiderdown.

The linking characteristic also allows the clusters to stay in place without shifting or creating empty spaces. Because of this special clinging ability, Northern Canadian Link Goose Down duvets must be made by hand from harvesting, to sorting, to sewing.
