The female eider duck plucks down from her breast to line her nest and cover the eggs. Once the nest is abandoned, the eiderdown is gathered. The birds are not disturbed, and are actually attracted to these safe areas by the farmers who supply food and protect these birds from poachers. This relationship between wild eider duck and farmer has existed for generations and helps insure the continued existence of a beautiful rare bird and a valuable resource.

Eiderdown is extremely rare, and is the softest, lightest and warmest down in the world.

Eiderdown's Unique Properties

- Contains no feathers with rigid quills that are likely to eventually pierce through the cotton casing and create discomfort, prevent down from expanding fully and break up over time into fragments devoid of any insulating value
- Tremendous elasticity and resistance to repeated compression means it never loses its lofting capacity
- A unique cohesiveness that prevents the creation of spaces in baffle boxes that lower the insulating properties
- Let's most body moisture escape, making it marvelously well adapted for high end bedding
- Durability unequalled by any other type of commercial down and to which no synthetic material can even come close.
